Subject: Interim Certificate to Operate (ICTO) for the ADTRAN ATLAS 890
Switch

1. In accordance with the authority provided by the reference, the Interoperability Test Panel (ITP) concurs with your request for an Interim Certificate to Operate (ICTO) with respect to the ADTRAN ATLAS 890 Switch. The ITP bases this concurrence upon your urgent operational requirement to field this system.
2. The ITP Chairman concurs with recommendations of the Joint Interoperability Test Command (JITC) and the ITP members, and grants an ICTO for use of the ADTRAN ATLAS 890 Switch while completing interoperability certification testing. This ICTO is effective beginning 24 September 2004 and expires on 30 November 2004. The ITP is issuing this ICTO as an administrative extension to the ADTRAN ATLAS 890 Switch dated 1 June 2004 that expired 30 September 2004.
3. If, at the end of this ICTO, ADTRAN ATLAS 890 has not been interoperability certified or the ITP has not granted an ICTO extension, the ITP will consider it as a candidate for removal from operational use.
