Subject: ITP Recommendation on the Interim Certificate to Operate (ICTO) for the
NUWC Division Keyport VoIP Network Cisco Call Manager Version 3.1(4b)
(Keyport VoIP)

1. In accordance with the authority provided by the reference, the Interoperability Test Panel (ITP) has reviewed and concurs with the US Naval Undersea Warfare Center (NUWC) Division Keyport request for an Interim Certificate to Operate (ICTO) for the NUWC Division Keyport VoIP Network Cisco Call Manager Version 3.1(4b) (Keyport VoIP). Concurrence of this ICTO is based upon an identified urgent operational requirement to field this system.

2. The ITP Chairman concurs with recommendations of the Joint Interoperability Test Command (JITC) and the ITP members, and recommends that ASD/NII as the DOD CIO grant an ICTO for testing purposes only, for the Keyport VoIP while interoperability certification testing is being completed. Testing is scheduled to be completed January 2005. The ITP Chairman further recommends that this ICTO be effective beginning 08 October 2003 and expires on 31 March 2005.

3. This ICTO should be subject to the following conditions:

- a. That NUWC Division Keyport comply with the following sequence of events:
 - 1). Obtain ICTO from the ITP Executive Agent.
 - 2). Obtain 100 additional lines for preliminary testing of existing Cisco CM 3.3.4 software from NAVCOMTELSTA, SUBASE, Bangor, Washington.
 - 3). Test and implement JTIC-approved CM 3.3.X software on existing 7845 hardware.
 - 4). Migrate existing users from in-service CM 3.1.4(b) system.
 - 5). Deactivate CM 3.1.4(b) due to IOP issues resulting in JTIC non-compliance.
 - 6). Add 900 additional users to JTIC-approved CM 3.3.X cluster, for a total of 1800 users (800 existing + 100 DID-test + 900 new).

b. That if at the end of this ICTO the Keyport VoIP has not been joint interoperability certified or the ITP has not granted an ICTO extension, the ITP will consider it as a candidate for removal from operational use.
